The throbbing heart of God in love

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, whose feast we celebrate on 24 June 2022. The use of Jesus' heart to symbolize his love is found in the writings of some medieval mystics and later fostered by Jesuit priests and promoted by St. Francis de Sales. According to Thomas Merton, **St. Lutgarde** (d.1246), a Belgian Cistercian mystic, was one of the great precursors of the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Sources say that Christ came in visitation to Lutgarde, offering her whatever gift of grace she desired. She asked for a better grasp of Latin so that she might better understand the Word of God and sing God's praise. Christ granted her request and Lutgarde's mind was flooded with the riches of psalms, antiphons, readings and responsories. However, her painful emptiness persisted. She returned to Christ, asking to return his gift and wondering if she might exchange it for another. "And for what would you exchange it?" Christ asked. "Lord," said Lutgarde, "I would exchange it for your heart." Christ then reached into Lutgarde and removing her heart within his breast.

St. Mechtilde of Helfts (d.1298) had many visions of Jesus' heart. Mechtilde reported that Jesus appeared to her in a vision and gave her his heart as a pledge of his love, as a place of refuge during her life and as consolation at the hour of her death. St. Gertrude the Great, who lived in the 13th century, when she was 26 years old, began to have visions of Jesus and his Sacred Heart. Through prayer, work, fasting and the revelations of Jesus, St. Gertrude became detached from everything that would hold her back from loving and being loved by Him. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque had a powerful encounter with the Sacred Heart of Jesus. She was a young French Sister in the 1600s. Over a number of weeks, she had a series of powerful visions and prayers centered on the Heart of Christ. She saw how His heart beats with love for us, at every moment of every day. He has a Risen Body and a heart that is both human and divine. Among Jesus's revelations to Margaret Mary was simply, "behold the Heart that has loved you so much." His heart continues to beat with love for me and you today. The saints take time to notice His love - through prayer, journaling and spiritual conversation. Margaret Mary teaches us to let our hearts beat in rhythm with the Heart of Christ. The devotion to the Sacred Heart was very important to **Don Bosco** because it focused on Jesus as our loving friend. He would tell his boys that the heart of Jesus was filled with acceptance, mercy and love. He would encourage them to open their hearts to that love, feel the embrace of Jesus and grow in friendship with him. As we prepare ourselves for this great feast, may each of us open ourselves to God's deepest love for us and all.

Listening is the foundation for genuine relationships and it is foundational to the relationship between God and humanity.
