Dearest Sisters,

Viva Gesu`!

Affectionate greetings to each one of you from Auxilium Provincial House. We commence the season of Lent with prayer, fasting and almsgiving on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022, and end at sundown Holy Thursday, April 14, 2022. The season of Lent is a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's resurrection at Easter. It is an opportunity for us to undertake the practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving as a means to know Christ better, love Him and follow His will more faithfully.

LENT 2022 - A FAYOURABLE TIME

In preparation for lent 2022, Pope Francis has released his annual message, reflecting on St. Paul's epistle to the Galatians 6:9-10 "Let us not grow tired of doing good, for, in due time, we shall reap our harvest, if we do not give up. Lent is a favourable time for personal and community renewal, as it leads us to the paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

SOWING AND REAPING: Lent invites us to conversion, to a change in mindset, so that life's truth and beauty may be found not so much in possessing as in giving, not so much in accumulating as in sowing and sharing goodness. The first to sow is God himself, who with great generosity "continues to sow abundant seeds of goodness in our human family". During Lent, we are called to respond to God's gift by accepting his word, which is «living and active». Regular listening to the word of God makes us open and docile to his work and bears fruit in our lives. This brings us great joy, yet even more, it summons us to become God's coworkers. By making good use of the present time, we too can sow seeds of goodness. This call to sow goodness should not be seen as a burden but a grace, whereby the Creator wishes us to be actively united with his bountiful goodness. The first fruit of the goodness we sow appears in ourselves and our daily lives, even in our little acts of kindness. In God, no act of love, no matter how small, and no «generous effort» will ever be lost.

"LET US NOT GROW TIRED OF DOING GOOD": Christ's resurrection enlivens earthly hopes with the "great hope" of eternal life, planting the seed of salvation in our present time. Bitter disappointment at shattered dreams, deep concern for the challenges ahead and discouragement at the poverty of our resources, can make us tempted to seek refuge in self-centredness and indifferent to the suffering of others. Yet God "gives strength to the weary, he strengthens the powerless. Those who hope in the Lord will regain their strength, they will soar on wings like eagles; though they run they will not grow weary, though they walk they will

never tire"Let us not grow tired - of praying, of uprooting evil from our lives, of asking for forgiveness in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, of fighting against concupiscence or grow tired of doing good in active charity towards our neighbours. During this Lent, let us practice almsgiving joyfully, evade addiction to "digital media" and cultivate more integral forms of communication made up of authentic encounters with real people, for digital media Pope says impoverishes human relationships

"IF WE DO NOT GIVE UP, WE SHALL REAP OUR HARVEST IN DUE

TIME": Each year during Lent we are reminded that "goodness, together with love, justice and solidarity, is not achieved once and for all; they have to be realized each day" (ibid., 11). Let us ask God to give us the patient perseverance of the farmer (cf. Jas 5:7), and to persevere in doing good, one step at a time. If we fall, let us stretch out our hand to the Father, who always lifts us up. If we are lost, if we are misled by the enticements of the evil one, let us not hesitate to return to God, who "is generous in forgiving" (Is 55:7). In this season of conversion, sustained by God's grace and by the communion of the Church, let us not grow tired of doing good. The soil is prepared by fasting, watered by prayer and enriched by charity. Let us believe firmly that "if we do not give up, we shall reap our harvest in due time" and that, with the gift of perseverance, we shall obtain what was promised (cf. Heb 10:36), for our salvation and the salvation of others (cf. 1 Tim 4:16). By cultivating fraternal love towards everyone, we are united to Christ, who gave his life for our sake (cf. 2 Cor 5:14-15), and we are granted a foretaste of the joy of the kingdom of heaven when God will be "all in all" (1Cor 15:28).

May the Virgin Mary, who bore the Saviour in her womb and "pondered all these things in her heart" (Lk 2:19), obtain for us the gift of patience. May she accompany us with her maternal presence, so that this season of conversion may bring forth fruits of eternal salvation.

WITHIN THE FAMILY:

IN SOLIDARITY WITH UKRAINE: The Mother General of the Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians, Mother Chiara Cazzuola, is in contact with the FMA of the communities of Kiev, Lviv, and Odessa who send news on the situation and their commitment to support the population. From the Community of Lviv, the FMA communicate that they are well and that their house is open to welcome the many people fleeing to save themselves from attacks, especially mothers with small children. And when they are in the shelter, they pray the rosary with the people, "This is our weapon! We thank in prayer those who are giving their lives to defend us and we thank God who has given us another day of life." Also, the Communities of Kiev and Odessa are in solidarity with the population, in a mutual exchange of concrete help and encouragement. The FMA Communities of Poland, in collaboration with the Church and Catholic associations, offer welcome and support to the many people who cross the borders to put themselves in safety with their families. Mother General invites all of us to make March 02, Ash Wednesday, a day of prayer and fasting for peace in Ukraine. A day to be close to the suffering of the Ukrainian people, to feel all as brothers and sisters, and implore from God the end of the war" (Pope Francis at the Angelus on Sunday 27 February). Mother Chiara thanks for the closeness expressed so far and encourages all the Educating Communities to remain united in prayer and the initiative of solidarity, with the insistent and unanimous request for the gift of peace, for Ukraine and for all areas of the world in conflict, in which the FMA share the fears and sufferings of the people. The Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians offers concrete support to the Ukrainian population in situations of danger and difficulty and counts on the generosity and
