My Dearest Sisters,

Fraternal greetings from Tiruchirappalli.

I wish you all the happy feast of Our Lady of Snow, the Patroness of our Province. Our hearts overflow with gratitude as we gladly observe the triune feast on August 05 - the commemoration of the foundation day of the Institute, bringing to life the voice of our Blessed Mother saying, "I entrust them to you"; the Feast of Our Lady of Snow, the Patroness of our Province; and the joyful commemoration of the First and Final commitment of some of our Sisters. We remember in prayer all those who have consecrated themselves to God and who will be making their First and Final profession on this day. Having faith that Mother Mary will lead us, let us look to the future with hope and perseverance as we work to fulfill Don Bosco's dream for our Institute, which is to be the living memorial of his gratitude to the Help of Christians and his thanks prolonged in time. May the Blessed Mother plead Her Son Jesus to shower our Province and Institute with spiritual graces and many more holy vocations.

As Don Bosco would repeat, "She who did it all," so can we as a Province exclaim that Mary walks with us, follows our footsteps, dispels gloom, and reassures us with her motherly concern to take up our daily commitment of fidelity to the mission of Christ in the Church of today.

This month I would like to reflect with you on "A Community Living in Harmony".

Life in a Religious Community is the earthly version of the Kingdom of God. Everyone wishes to be in communion, to love, and to be loved. Obviously, communion and community life are not one and the same. We come together and live in a community for a double purpose: to help each other to get closer to God and to fulfill a common mission. A community helps us to reach both of these goals. It is the place where we calm our tensions and replenish our energy for our mission. A religious with a caring community around her is significantly more enthusiastic and joyful about her mission.

This resonant witness comes from the earliest Mornesian community: there, they had only love and hence, a future! It was a loving community that aimed to unite all the children into "one heart and one soul" in Christ as a 'sign' of its concern for them. There was an unseen protagonist of communion at work in the group and in each person's heart... It was evident in Mary Domenica's clear vision when she wrote to the Sisters, "It is the hand of God which works in you." (MM L 66, 2.) For this reason, Mother was astounded by the kindness that pervaded and the sisterly bond that existed, which made her wonder and be amazed.

Fr. Pestarino also perceived the Sisters' fellowship as a "blessing" from God and Mary, and this gave him consolation and edification. With a feeling of tremendous confidence, he described in

his first report to Don Bosco how there was "a true union of spirit, of charity, full harmony and holy joy among all" in the community, from shared work to recreation, from prayer to the educational purpose.

Building a community in daily life was a challenge, a patient apprenticeship filled with struggles and a spiritual practice, for the first community as it is for all of our communities today. Our communities are naturally comprised of our human weaknesses requiring continual reconciliation in the monotonous events of everyday life and in a rich combination of our poor human relationships. In the community, we live a Salesian style, where everything is carried out in creative fidelity, promoting the spirit of family and fraternity, which does not level everyone to the same mould, nor lumps everyone together into one crowd; rather it favours the expression of personal richness in participation and co-responsibility. Every member is called not only to become competent, remain faithful to her task and respect that of others, but also to show herself open to all, grateful for the presence of others and the wealth of their unique contribution.

We have all been created, each of us, as unique and unrepeatable melodies, which can be realized only if the right notes and right chords are played, composing the song of our life, contributing to the symphony called the community. Thus, in the community the most precious gift we can offer someone is to support them lovingly as they strive to become the best version of themselves -that is, to become who God always intended them to be. Only so, a true harmony can be established which takes the personal dignity and mutual respect equally into consideration, demands personal commitment of each one to the perfection of communion within a community.

Communion is the sweet melody created in unison, and the community is the arrangement of notes and chords and the interplay of the varied instruments. The notes, the chords and the instruments are prerequisites, but not enough to create the melody... the player brings them together in the act of playing, and thus is created the resounding melody. Just so, having a community, the house, a mission, the roles defined and the infrastructure does not create communion by default. It has to be the act of the Holy Spirit who infuses the spirit of love and respect that makes the sweet melody of communion, come alive. That melody is a proclamation, the announcing of the Good News of God to all who are around. The important task is that each of us asks oneself, what do I do to build up a true communion of hearts and minds wherever I live and work?

May be the following qualities can serve as criteria to create a community of communion and harmony: being unconditionally kind to the other; forgiving without keeping the count; reconciling readily putting one's ego aside; growing in abounding gratitude; developing a genuine mutual appreciation; spreading hope without false promises, extending hospitality without discrimination; practising humility without pretensions; and maturing in patience filled with endurance.

May our communities become hubs of communion announcing the Lord of harmony and love.
