My dear Sisters

Tiruchirapalli - India

Cordial greetings and prayerful wishes from Tiruchirappalli.

I acknowledge with gratitude, the love and hospitality shown by the communities with whom I had the initial visit. It has been a wonderful experience to meet the Sisters and get to know them personally, their life, their ministry and activities, the challenges and difficulties, besides their joys and achievements. My sincere thanks to everyone who made the necessary arrangements, taking utmost care and showing extraordinary interest in making the visits significant.

For the formative part of this month's communication with you, I wish to reflect with you on "Fidelity to the Charism of the Origins".

Charism is a divine gift that helps in building the Church. For religious communities, the charism is the soul of their life in common, giving it purpose, motivation and animating its action. Charism involves history, traditions, rule and norms of life, apostolate and spirituality, customs and heritage, all of which make it what it is. Together, these elements help the members grow in their identity and call to holiness, develop an intimate bond with the Trinitarian God, and more broadly, become a symbol and messenger of God's love to the world.

Understanding and recognizing Salesian charism begins with appreciating the spiritual qualities bestowed upon Don Bosco for the purpose of educating and evangelizing the poor youth. Even today, people who are called to participate in the mission of St. John Bosco and St. Mary Mazzarello continue to receive these gifts from the Holy Spirit. We, the Salesian Sisters, consecrated women in the Church, who live in communities, express our radical love for Christ in our loving relationships with each other and in the service to the young in joyful simplicity.

Characteristics of our Charism

The Charismatic Elements of our Charism, namely the centrality of the Sacraments of Eucharist & Reconciliation, filial devotion to Our Blessed Mother, love for the Pope, pastoral charity, joy and optimism, work and temperance, and life in communities, constantly require a revitalization. Each of these elements is crucial to living out our Salesian Charism, and each of them is imprinted in the heart of every Salesian Sister. St. John Bosco, our holy founder, defined these for us, and we hold fast to his method, and his plan evermore willingly and joyfully.

<u>Eucharist & Reconciliation:</u> Don Bosco had a great devotion to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, and believed that frequent Communion and Confession were the secret to creating a happy and peaceful atmosphere at school, where young people could grow in faith. He repeated often to his boys, "If you are in need of many graces, go more often to visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament."

Regarding confessions, Don Bosco said, "First of all, do everything you can to avoid offending God, but if unfortunately, you should commit sin, do not let the devil prevail upon you to not confess it. Remember that the confessor is a father who is eager to do all he can for you and help to protect you from all possible harm."

We participate in the celebration of the Eucharist daily, and try to visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament as often as we can. We also say a special prayer called 'the Visit to the Blessed Sacrament' in the middle of the day.

<u>Devotion to Our Blessed Mother</u>: Mother Mary, who served as Don Bosco's mentor and counsellor, began her special rapport with him from his dream when he was nine. He pictured Mary as the omnipresent Mother who attended to her children's needs, heard their pleas, and supported them on their way to heaven. Don Bosco first learnt how to pray the Angelus from his mother, Mamma Margaret. Later, in finding a name for the Sisters, he decided to call us Mary's Daughters, as he would define us, "living monuments in gratitude to Mary". The Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians continues today to hold on to this self-identity that Don Bosco intended, and prays daily entrusting itself to Mary, Help of Christians.

Love for the Pope: Don Bosco remained constant in his filial love and loyalty to the Holy Father during a period of great unrest and struggle in Italy, in a time when many were antagonistic to the Pope and to the Church in Rome. He taught his sons to say, "Viva il Papa" (Long live Pope!), and encouraged a special affection for the Roman Pontiff. We still follow Don Bosco's example and pray for the Holy Father every day. We continue to promote the love for the Pope and that young people should turn to him for moral and religious advice. We still certainly affirm Don Bosco's statement that "the Pope's wish should be our norm".

<u>Pastoral Charity:</u> The foundation and culmination of Salesian Spirituality is pastoral charity. St. John Bosco and St. Mary Mazzarello prioritized their love for young people in their lives. In reality, these two holy founders of ours, gave their entire life to Christ, in and through the service of the young. They counted no cost when it came to serving the young and hardly took time for themselves. They were renowned for their unending tolerance with young people. Don Bosco would tell the educators, looking at the negligent pupils sent out of the classrooms, "be patient with their light-mindedness."

Joy & Optimism: "A joyful heart is the sign of a great love for the Lord"- this is our lifestyle just as St. Mary Mazzarello relentlessly taught. Salesian homes and schools are renowned for being happy environments where joy abounds and laughter fills the corridors and classrooms. Don Bosco and Mother Mazzarello had a positive outlook on life and a joy-filled world view. They could not but see and affirm the promise in everything. "Always try to think well of others," advised St. John Bosco, "at the very least, give them credit for their good intentions. Never return to them the wrongs that have previously been pardoned."

Hard Work: Mother Mazzarello and Don Bosco were both known for their strenuous labour and their insistence with their followers on working hard and incessantly. Work, hard work, yes! But for what? "Da Mihi Animas" - the first half of Don Bosco's motto explains it all. The salvation of the young was the highest of his priorities and he was determined to leave no stones unturned for the sake of it. We are still renowned for being tenacious workers, who are never hesitant of any type of work, in order to assist the young at all times. Working hard is the joy of our life, not a predicament!

<u>Salesian Community:</u> St. John Bosco says, "If we practice charity, every community will be a little heaven." The Salesian ideal of creating a home of our educational institutions springs from the experience of home lived among the people engaged in the educative mission, that is among the Sisters in the Salesian community, and those who form part of the educating community - that includes everyone who makes up the setting that educates the young. The heart of the Salesian approach and charism continues to be the wellbeing of this community and its shared quest for sanctity.

Thus, by living the elements of our Charism we dedicate ourselves to those young people who are the poorest, to those who for various reasons have less possibilities and limited scope, and those that are exposed to danger. Our missionary zeal is expressed in our deliberate choice for Education as the privileged way to Gospel citizenship.

BLESSEDS SR. CARMEN MORENO BENITEZ AND SR. AMPARO CARBONELL MUÑOZ: September 06, 2023 marks the 87th anniversary of the martyrdom of the Blesseds Sr. Carmen Moreno Benitez FMA and Sr. Amparo Carbonell Muñoz FMA, during the Spanish Civil War (1936-1939). Though they had the possibility of saving their lives to escape to Italy on 07 August 1936, at the beginning of the civil war, they decided to stay with Sr. Carmen Xammar, who had just been operated on and was not in a condition to travel. At dawn on 06 September 1936, in the Barcelona hippodrome, the two FMAs were shot. A few days earlier, they had been arrested along with a third Sister, sick and just out of the hospital, who was released. Thus, they sacrificed their lives for love and stand as models to the supreme witness of faith and fraternal charity. May God grant us the grace to respond generously to God's call with coherent faith in the trials of life and with the gift of ourselves with love and joy.

NATIVITY OF BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: On September 08, we celebrate the Nativity of Blessed Virgin Mary and "The Girl Child Day in India". When God chose to send His Son into the world, to take human flesh, he chose a woman, Mary. This choice of a woman is indeed worth reflecting on, because it indicates God's way of doing extraordinary things, ordinarily. Right through the history of humankind, there have been violations of the basic rights of women, subjected to various forms of disrespect and exploitation in society, especially in our own country. Rapes, abuse, female feticides and infanticides, dowry, sexual exploitation etc.... have become part of everyday news reports. As we celebrate Mary's birth let us contemplate the new beginning that God brought about in her and with her. Let our celebrations increase the room for hope and peace in our hearts and a greater acceptance of the Girl Children in the world, recognizing their equal dignity and the right for opportunities in the society.

Looking to the example of Mary, may we too unite our sufferings to our Lord, facing them with courage, love, and trust.

STS. MICHAEL, GABRIEL AND RAPHAEL: On September 29, the Church celebrates the Archangels: Saints Michael, Gabriel and Raphael! Each of these archangels performs a different

mission as we witness in Scriptures: Michael protects; Gabriel announces; Raphael heals. They are messengers sent by God, to communicate to us something that God wishes to. They bring us good news, heal our sicknesses and do many special favours in our lives. In their presence we recognize that we are never alone, but surrounded by the glory of God. Let us entrust ourselves to the spiritual presence of these magnificent Beings, that they may help us fight against the seductions of the evil one and enable us to avoid any the wrong choices in our life's daily journey.
