With deep affection, I greet you for the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes that she may bless each one of us with good health, so that we may serve the Lord with Joy.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES AND WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

Every year, on 11 February, the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, the Holy Father addresses the sick, the poor, the excluded, all those who "are burdened" as well as carers and health workers. His intention is to give them a message of comfort and hope to help them continue their journey, following the path revealed by our Lord Jesus Christ, through the intercession of Mary. "Jesus does not make demands of those who endure situations of frailty, suffering and weakness, but offers his mercy and his comforting presence. He looks upon a wounded humanity with eyes that gaze into the heart of each person". In fact, Jesus loves also the weak and the fragile for "He himself became frail, endured human suffering and received comfort from his Father". And speaking, specifically of those who live the experience of the disease, he adds: "At times human warmth is lacking in our approach to these. What is needed is a personalized approach to the sick, not just of *curing* but also of *caring*, in view of an integral human healing. In experiencing illness, individuals not only feel threatened in their physical integrity, but also in the relational, intellectual, affective and spiritual dimensions of their lives. For this reason, in addition to therapy and support, they expect care and attention. In a word, love. At the side of every sick person, there is also a family, which itself suffers and is in need of support and comfort." Jesus, therefore, urges each one: "Come to me". In him, you will find strength to face all the worries and questions that assail you during this "dark night" of body and soul. Christ did not give us prescriptions, but through his passion, death and resurrection he frees us from the grip of evil". 7MA constitution article 59 states: "Let the entire community surround the sick or elderly Sister with affectionate consideration and support her in all her needs...Let the Sister who is tried by suffering or illness be comforted by the certainty that she shares more intimately in Christ's redeeming mystery and in this way contributes to strengthening sisterly communion and expansion of the mission of the Institute."

YEAR OF YOUTH - TAMIL NADU: Pope Francis published his Apostolic Exhortation **Christus Vivit** on 2 April, 2019. He emphasizes that young people who live vibrantly their lives must renew their youthfulness in Christ and acquire the power to change the world today through their talents, audacity and creativity. Focusing on the exhortations of our Holy Father, the Circular of Tamil Nadu Bishops' Council, has declared 2020 as the year of youth on the theme "**Young People – With Power Towards Change**".

The icon of the Youth Year imprinted on the flag will be sent to each community to be hoisted to mark the inauguration of the celebration in the month of February, 2020. Based on the Christus Vivit, articles will be sent to the communities on the following themes to prepare the young people for the Youth Fest.

August Participating in the welfare of the Society by creative expression of the local

culture (CV: 224 - 229)

September Young people participating in politics (CV: 230 - 238)

October Young people creating sustainable economy

November Transcending caste and creed to create an egalitarian society

December Young people in communion with God and humanity

In keeping with the theme and the objective of our General Chapter XXIV, we are encouraged to animate the young people on the above themes involving the Educating Community and the Salesian Family. Details of the celebration of the Youth year will be sent to the communities soon.

NEXT THREE-YEAR WYD CYCLE: Pope Francis has chosen the themes for the next three-year WYD cycle, which culminates with the international event scheduled for 2022 in Lisbon:

2020 - "Young man, I say to you, arise! Luke 7:14

2021 - "Stand up. I appoint you as a witness of what you have seen." Acts 26:16

2022 - "Mary arose and went with haste." Luke 1:39

These themes are connected with the most recent WYD in Panama, the synodal process that led to Chrisus Vivit. I take this opportunity to greet all the Young People a fruitful year. Through them may the world abound with abundant happiness, fullness of life and everlasting love.
