As we celebrate this wonderful Feast of the Sacred Heart, let us take to our hearts, the inspiration from Don Bosco's recommendations. May the Sacred Heart of Jesus fill our hearts with His boundless love and mercy, inspiring us to live daily His teachings, with renewed zeal and devotion.
